The Club's History

Canons Brook Golf Club was designed by Sir Henry Cotton, whose philosophy was to create a championship length course with very little rough, but incorporating many bunkers and large undulating greens, a task he accomplished with style. The course was officially opened in 1966.

Sir Henry has designed the course in such a way that the aspiring golfer must exhibit a wide repertoire of shots if they are to master the course. It was his intention that regardless of standard, every golfer should be rewarded for thoughtful and skilful play, rather than power alone. Situated in 112 acres of mature rolling countryside, the 18 hole, 6,769 yard par 73 championship course makes excellent use of the surrounding landscape and its numerous natural and man made hazards and beautiful features.

The Canons Brook, from which the club takes it's name, meanders through various parts of the course. The Brook, as it is known, catches many a golf ball for those that fail to treat it with respect.

The twelfth hole is Sir Henry Cottons' signature hole and typifies all the holes on the course. Seemingly simple, but surrounded with problems and should be well thought out. Sir Henry Cotton enjoyed considerable success as a golfer winning the Open Championship on three occasions. He was widely renowned as the top British golfer of his time and played in four Ryder Cup tournaments.

This rich and successful history and his unique vision have created a golf course which should be a must for any golfer who appreciates a challenge and wants to play what is probably the best course in Essex.

The Outward Nine



Brookside

A difficult hole to start and your first encounter with Canons Brook which runs from right to left across the hole. With out of bounds on the right hand side of the hole, this is not the time to slice your tee shot or your second shot.



Oakside

Once again, do not slice your ball on this hole as out of bounds runs the entire length of the hole. The green is fringed with trees, mounds and bunkers, not to mention the pond on the left hand side. Approach with care.



Ridge

A long dogleg left hole which is considered the hardest hole on the course. With trees and shrubs on both sides of the fairway, a straight drive must be the preferred option. Wander left or right at your peril.



Moule Hill

The first of the par 5 holes and at Stroke Index 3, the hardest of all four of them. Out of bounds on the right hand side of the fairway and numerous trees and shrubs on the left, make a straight drive essential.



Cotton's Cradle

A not too difficult par 3 hole, however you must be accurate. Anything left or right will find trees and anything short or long will find the strategically placed bunkers. Easy at first view, but full of problems.



Hillview

Long and looks to invite the long drive, however, it must be straight because there are plenty of trees waiting for the errant shot. The green is closely guarded by a number of bunkers so be accurate with your approach.



Table Mount

The elevated green is surrounded by slopes which will carry your ball away from the target. Trees, shrubs and two green side bunkers make this par 3 hole an intimidating prospect.



Norton Rise

Take care with your drive and avoid the two bunkers on the left hand side of the fairway ready to catch your shot. Also beware on your approach shot as out of bounds fringes the left half of the green.



Bunkers

Out of bounds on the left hand side of the fairway and a bunker paced in the right centre of the fairway just where your drive lands, make this a difficult driving hole. Your approach also has to negotiate two well placed bunkers.



The Inward Nine



Harvey's Hyde

A very long and troublesome par 4 with bunkers well placed to collect a slightly wayward drive. Your approach shot must be really accurate as out of bounds runs very close to the left hand side of the green.



Beaton Track

A par 5 with attitude, water on the left hand side, out of bounds on the right hand side and a long winding fairway. Considered the second hardest hole on the course, it should be played with safety in mind.



Willow Pond

The signature hole and a true test of golfing accuracy. Your tee shot must clear the water and avoid the large and well placed green side bunkers. Any deviation right or left will certainly cost you a shot or three.



Chimney View

You drive up and over the brow of the hill to try and keep your ball on the fairway. It is the second shot which is the problematic one as out of bounds will welcome any over hit shot. Anything short will find the fairway bunkers.



Cottages

Four bunkers on the right hand side of the fairway are strategically placed to capture your drive, with out of bounds on the right hand side and trees and shrubs on the right. Only the accurate will walk away with par at this hole.



Royal Road

A long par 3 with plenty to beware of. Out of bounds runs down the right hand side and four green side bunkers have been placed in very awkward positions ready to catch that slight hook.



Poplars

A tree lined fairway on both sides make this a very interesting hole. Out of bounds on the right will gather any sliced shot and when you approach the green you will have to negotiate the guarding bunkers.



Death or Glory

As the name suggests, this hole whilst not being the longest par 4, is one of the most difficult. Tree lined fairway, and approaches which have to cross Canons Brook, not once, but twice. This really is death or glory.



Costain's Canons

A true test of golf to finish, with Canons Brook and out of bounds running the full length on the right. Trees and plantations on the left and the green tucked away behind more trees over the brook. A great finishing hole.

Golfing Competitions

Canons Brook Golf Club operate a large number of competitions throughout the year and these can be played in a variety of ways. Whilst Medal or Stroke play is the most popular competition format for major events, we have compiled a compendium of other possible vents. The basic rules can vary from club to club.

Foursomes

A team of two players who play alternate shots, i.e., one player tees off, player two hits the second shot, player one the third shot, and so on until they have holed out. Player two then tees off at the second hole and again the players play alternate shots. Before starting play, it would be wise to work out where the toughest driving holes fall, so the best driver of the two tees off on these holes.

Greensomes

This is a variation on Foursomes, the only difference being that both players tee off on each hole and then decide which drive to select. If they decide to take the drive of player one, the other player plays the next shot and they alternate until they have holed out.

Match Play

This format is such that each hole becomes a separate competition. It can be played as an individual or two man team event where the winner of the hole is the person who achieved the lowest net score. They are then said to be one up. The game finishes when the number of holes up exceeds the number of holes left to play.

Medal/Stroke Play

This is an individual event where you are playing against your handicap. Each hole is played and the total number of strokes taken for that hole are recorded onto your score card. When all the holes have been played, the total number of strokes taken are recorded as your gross score. You then deduct the number of strokes allowed by your handicap and this will give you your net score. The winner is the person with the lowest net score in your division.

Shotgun

This can be played as any format with the normal rules applying. It is a social competition where all the players/teams tee off at the sound of a shotgun, allowing all players to start and finish at the same time. The social part takes place at the nineteenth hole where there is the presentation to the winners and runners up.



otitions



Stableford

An individual or team event where instead of strokes being recorded, points are awarded on a sliding scale. After allowing for your handicap, your net score on each hole will attract the following points, 3 under par, 5 points, 2 under par, 4 points, 1 under par, 3 points, level par, 2 points, 1 over par, 1 point and no points for anything above this.

Texas Scramble

A team event where all players tee off and the team agree which drive they prefer. They then all take their second shots from this point. They then decide on the best second shot and take their third shots from this point. This continues until the ball has been holed out. It is usual for each player to have their tee shot selected at least four times over the eighteen holes. A real fun format where some remarkably low scores can be achieved.









Our Facilities
